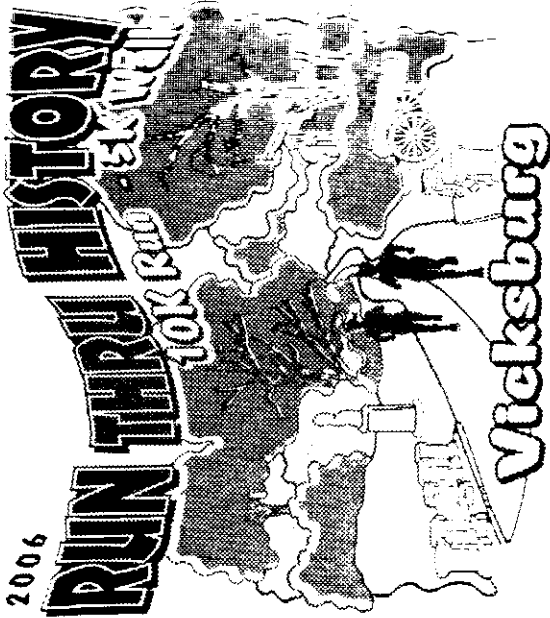

## 10K RUN THRU HISTORY

**Starting Time** - 8:30 a.m.  
**Starting Place** - Memorial Arch  
**Finish** - Battlefield Inn  
**Course** - Two loops; paved road in Vicksburg Military Park; TAC sanctioned & certified; time splits every mile; aid stations.

Vicksburg National Military Park was established in 1899 to commemorate the 47 day siege that ended on July 4, 1863, opening the Mississippi River to Union vessels, dividing the Confederacy, thus marking the beginning of the end. The race route takes you past cannons, fortifications and trenches that have remained from the siege. You may also notice numerous markers that have been erected to mark the location of specific military actions and that identify the military units involved. The large, prominent marble and granite monuments were erected by the various states to recognize the efforts of their native sons. Vicksburg National Military Park is administered by the National Park Service of the Department of the Interior.
