The historic Vicksburg National Military Park commemorates the Civil War campaign of the Siege of Vicksburg. As the last Confederate stronghold on the Mississippi River, President Lincoln described its seizure as key to ending the war. Today it plays host to one of Mississippi's oldest and largest road races, with its scenic course winding through Union and Confederate battle lines.
